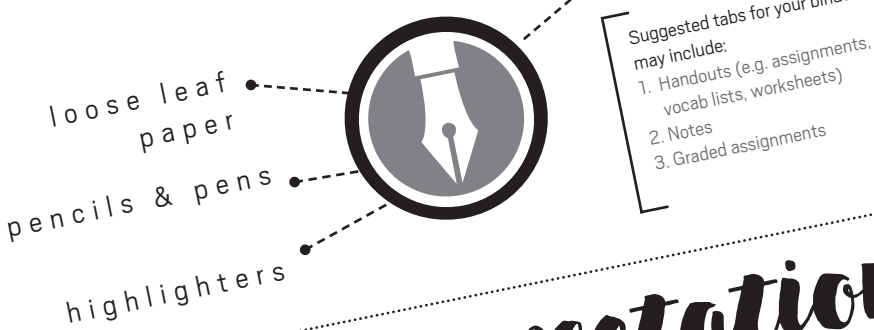

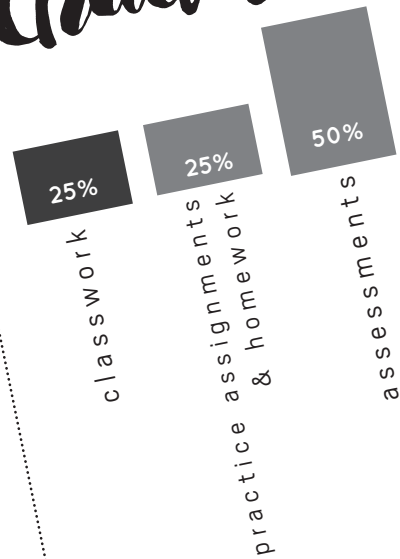

Rules & Expectations

RESPECT

Grades will be available on Progress Book. Grades are updated 1-2 times a week.

- Please **check Progress Book regularly**, and feel free to ask any questions that you might have about a particular grade. If you feel a mistake has been made, please contact Mrs. Horvath before or after class or via e-mail.
- If you do not have a Progress Book login, you can **get one from the front office**.

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Absentee Policy

- 1 YES – WE DID SOMETHING IMPORTANT WHILE YOU WERE ABSENT.** It is your responsibility to check with Mrs. Horvath the day you return to class to find out what you missed. Check the **ABSENT WORK BIN or class website** to find any handouts you missed.
- 2** You have **ONE DAY for each day you are absent** to make up missed work. After that day, any missing assignments will be accepted with a late penalty.
- 3 e-submission policy:** You are always welcome to e-mail your assignments. There is no excuse to not have an assignment in on time. **Printer and Internet issues are not an excuse.** If technology failures happen, hand-write your assignment.
- 4** Any assignment you are absent for will be entered as a **ZERO until it is turned in.**

Homework & Other Policies



***Late work IS** accepted for **50%** of the grade.

***EXTRA CREDIT POLICY:** Extra credit is considered on an individual basis; however, you must have all your missing work turned in and have below a 75% in the class to be eligible for extra credit.

***TEST/QUIZ RETAKE:** Tests or quiz retakes will be considered on an individual basis. Please see Mrs. Horvath if you are interested in retaking a test or quiz.



***LIFE HAPPENS!** If you are having issues at school or at home, have a huge exam coming up, or realize you need more time to complete your absolute best work for any other reason, e-mail Mrs. Horvath and request an extension. **You must come talk to Mrs. Horvath or send an e-mail the day before** for the extension to be granted. You cannot come in 5 minutes before class without your assignment and expect an extension.



***Friendly Reminder: Google Translate and other online translators or apps should only be used when absolutely necessary and ONLY as a dictionary (used to look up one word at a time). They should not be used to translate complete sentences, paragraphs, or papers.** If Mrs. Horvath suspects you have used an online translator to complete your work, it will be **treated as cheating.**

Cell Phone Policy

Cell phones and other devices are welcome; however, they must be used for school purposes only. Please refer to the BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) Stoplight on the bulletin board EACH DAY to see if we will be using devices in class. Please note: If we are in "red," no devices will be allowed in class. They should be on silent and put away.

Consequences for having devices out in "red":

- 1** Warning; student is told to put away the device
- 2** Device is confiscated by Mrs. Horvath and held for the remainder of the class period. Student may collect the device after class
- 3** Device is taken to the office
- 4** Punishment is given by the office
